

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND INTENT TO ENACT GOODHUE COUNTY CASCADE CANOE & KAYAK ACCESS RULES ORDINANCE 21-1**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the County of Goodhue, Minnesota will hold a public hearing in person and via telephone or other electronic means as described below on Tuesday, June 7, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. at the Goodhue County Board Room, 509 W 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Room 308, Red Wing, Minnesota, to consider the revision of the Goodhue County Cascade Canoe & Kayak Access Rules Ordinance to modify regulations regarding alcohol and tobacco use, parking, and motorized vehicle operation.
